AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the class E felony of failure to report child abuse

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 260.40 to 2 read as follows:

3 S 260.40 FAILURE TO REPORT CHILD ABUSE.

A PERSON IS GUILTY OF FAILURE TO REPORT CHILD ABUSE WHEN, BEING EIGH5 TEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, HE OR SHE FAILS TO REPORT TO A POLICE OFFI6 CER OR LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, AS SOON AS HE OR SHE IS PHYSICALLY ABLE,
7 THE COMMISSION OF ANY CRIME DEFINED IN THIS CHAPTER AGAINST A CHILD
8 UNDER THE AGE OF SIXTEEN YEARS, AND SUCH PERSON WITNESSES THE COMMISSION
9 OF SUCH CRIME AND HAS REASON TO KNOW THAT HE OR SHE IS WITNESSING A
10 CRIME.

- 11 FAILURE TO REPORT CHILD ABUSE IS A CLASS E FELONY.
- 12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
