AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to granting academic credit at state operated institutions of the state university of New York and the senior colleges of the city university of New York to veterans

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 669-e 2 to read as follows:

3 S 669-E. COURSE CREDIT FOR VETERANS. 1. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, 4 MEANS A PERSON, MALE OR FEMALE, RESIDENT OF THIS THE TERM "VETERAN" 5 STATE, WHO HAS SERVED IN THE ACTIVE MILITARY OR NAVAL SERVICE OF THE 6 DURING A WAR IN WHICH THE UNITED STATES ENGAGED AND WHO UNITED STATES HAS BEEN RELEASED FROM SUCH SERVICE BY ANY MEANS OTHER THAN BY DISHONOR-7 8 ABLE DISCHARGE, OR WHO HAS BEEN FURLOUGHED TO THE RESERVE.

9 2. EVERY VETERAN WHO IS ENROLLED ON A FULL-TIME BASIS AS AN UNDERGRAD-10 UATE STUDENT IN GOOD STANDING, AT AN INSTITUTION WITHIN THE STATE 11 UNIVERSITY SYSTEM, SHALL UPON APPLICATION BE GRANTED UP TO SIX ACADEMIC CREDITS PER YEAR AND SIXTY CREDITS IN THE AGGREGATE TOWARDS HIS 12 OR HER 13 DEGREE FOR COMPLETION OF COURSES THAT WERE PART OF SUCH VETERAN'S MILI-TARY TRAINING OR SERVICE IF THE COMPLETED COURSES MEET THE STANDARDS OF 14 15 THE AMERICAN COUNCIL ON EDUCATION OR ITS EQUIVALENT FOR THE AWARDING OF ACADEMIC CREDITS. NO FEE, TUITION OR OTHER CHARGE 16 SHALL BEASSESSED WHO QUALIFIES 17 AGAINST A VETERAN FOR SUCH CREDIT PURSUANT TO THIS 18 SECTION.

19 3. THE BOARDS OF TRUSTEES OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE CITY UNIVER-20 SITY OF NEW YORK SHALL ADOPT SUCH PROCEDURES AS ARE NECESSARY TO FULLY 21 IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

22 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of July next succeeding 23 the date on which it shall have become a law.
