AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to creating the bill of adoptee rights

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section  
2     4138-e to read as follows:  
3     S 4138-E. BILL OF ADOPTEE RIGHTS. 1. (A) COMMENCING ON JANUARY FIRST,  
4     TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION TWO OR THREE OF  
5     THIS SECTION, AND NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF ANY OTHER LAW, A  
6     PERSON EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR MORE WHO WAS BORN IN THIS STATE AND THEN  
7     ADOPTED AND WHOSE LONG-FORM BIRTH CERTIFICATE WAS THEN SEALED IN THIS  
8     STATE, MAY OBTAIN A CERTIFIED COPY OF SUCH LONG-FORM BIRTH CERTIFICATE  
9     FROM THE DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION. (B) SUCH A CERTI-  
10    FIED COPY OF A LONG-FORM BIRTH CERTIFICATE SUPPLIED BY THE DEPARTMENT

1 SHALL INCLUDE A LEGEND, APPEARING PROMINENTLY ON EACH PAGE OF THE DOCU-  
2 MENT PROVIDED, STATING AS FOLLOWS:

3 THIS IS A CERTIFIED COPY OF AN ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE. THIS  
4 ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE HAS BEEN SUPERSEDED BY ANOTHER CERTIFICATE ON  
5 FILE WITH THE APPROPRIATE GOVERNMENT AGENCY.

6 2. AT ANY TIME PRIOR TO JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN, A PERSON  
7 LISTED AS A BIRTH PARENT ON A CONFIDENTIAL LONG-FORM BIRTH CERTIFICATE  
8 MAY, IN WRITING, CONFIRM THAT HE OR SHE WISHES TO MAINTAIN THE CONFIDEN-  
9 TIALITY OF SUCH DOCUMENT. IF A WRITTEN CONFIRMATION AS DESCRIBED IN THIS  
10 SUBDIVISION IS RECEIVED FROM SUCH A BIRTH PARENT BY THE DEPARTMENT ON OR  
11 BEFORE JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN, THEN PARAGRAPH (A) OF  
12 SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO SUCH LONG-FORM BIRTH  
13 CERTIFICATE PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT PARAGRAPH (A) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF  
14 THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY ON OR AFTER THAT DATE IF, AFTER SUCH CONFIRMA-  
15 TION IS RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT, SUCH BIRTH PARENT DIES OR THE  
16 CONFIRMATION IS WITHDRAWN BY SUCH BIRTH PARENT IN WRITING, AND NO OTHER  
17 TIMELY CONFIRMATION REMAINS ON FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT FROM A LIVING  
18 BIRTH PARENT.

19 3. A PERSON EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR MORE WHO WAS BORN IN THIS STATE  
20 AND THEN ADOPTED AND WHOSE LONG-FORM BIRTH CERTIFICATE WAS THEN SEALED  
21 IN THIS STATE, MAY OBTAIN A CERTIFIED COPY OF HIS OR HER LONG-FORM BIRTH  
22 CERTIFICATE, AS DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (B) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS  
23 SECTION, UPON SUPPLYING PROOF THAT ALL BIRTH PARENTS LISTED ON SUCH  
24 DOCUMENT HAVE DIED.

25 4. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMULGATE AND MAKE PUBLICLY AVAILABLE FORMS  
26 THAT A BIRTH PARENT MAY USE TO PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT WITH A WRITTEN  
27 CONFIRMATION OR WITHDRAWAL OF CONFIRMATION UNDER THIS SECTION, AND FOR  
28 CONFIRMING THAT A PERSON WHO HAS MADE SUCH A WRITTEN CONFIRMATION OR  
29 WITHDRAWAL IS, IN FACT, A PERSON IDENTIFIED ON THE BIRTH CERTIFICATE AS  
30 A BIRTH PARENT, AND FOR CONFIRMING THE SUFFICIENCY OF PROOF OF THE DEATH  
31 OF A PERSON LISTED ON A BIRTH CERTIFICATE AS A BIRTH PARENT.

32 5. (A) A BIRTH PARENT MAY AT ANY TIME REQUEST FROM THE DEPARTMENT A  
33 CONTACT PREFERENCE FORM THAT SHALL ACCOMPANY A BIRTH CERTIFICATE ISSUED  
34 UNDER THIS TITLE. THE CONTACT PREFERENCE FORM SHALL PROVIDE THE FOLLOW-  
35 ING INFORMATION TO BE COMPLETED AT THE OPTION OF THE BIRTH PARENT:

36 (I) I WOULD LIKE TO BE CONTACTED.

37 (II) I WOULD PREFER TO BE CONTACTED ONLY THROUGH AN INTERMEDIARY.

38 (III) I HAVE COMPLETED A MEDICAL HISTORY FORM AND HAVE FILED IT WITH  
39 THE DEPARTMENT.

40 (IV) PLEASE DO NOT CONTACT ME. IF I DECIDE LATER THAT I WOULD LIKE TO  
41 BE CONTACTED, I WILL SUBMIT AN UPDATED CONTACT PREFERENCE FORM TO THE  
42 DEPARTMENT.

43 (B) THE MEDICAL HISTORY FORM SHALL BE IN A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE  
44 DEPARTMENT AND SHALL BE SUPPLIED TO THE BIRTH PARENT UPON REQUEST OF A  
45 CONTACT PREFERENCE FORM FROM THE DEPARTMENT. ONLY THOSE PERSONS WHO ARE  
46 AUTHORIZED TO PROCESS APPLICATIONS MADE UNDER THIS TITLE MAY PROCESS  
47 CONTACT PREFERENCE FORMS, MEDICAL HISTORY FORMS, AND CORRESPONDENCE AND  
48 REQUESTS MADE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.

49 (C) THE MEDICAL HISTORY AND CONTACT PREFERENCE FORMS DESCRIBED IN THIS  
50 SUBDIVISION ARE CONFIDENTIAL COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE BIRTH PARENT TO THE  
51 PERSON NAMED ON THE CONFIDENTIAL LONG-FORM BIRTH CERTIFICATE AND SHALL  
52 BE PLACED IN SEPARATE SEALED ENVELOPES UPON RECEIPT FROM THE BIRTH  
53 PARENT. THE SEALED ENVELOPES SHALL BE MATCHED WITH AND PLACED IN THE  
54 FILE CONTAINING THE CONFIDENTIAL ORIGINAL LONG-FORM BIRTH CERTIFICATE.  
55 SUCH SEALED ENVELOPES CONTAINING THE CONTACT PREFERENCE FORM AND MEDICAL  
56 HISTORY FORM SHALL BE RELEASED TO A PERSON AUTHORIZED TO RECEIVE A

1 CERTIFIED COPY OF HIS OR HER ORIGINAL LONG-FORM BIRTH CERTIFICATE PURSU-  
2 ANT TO THIS SECTION.

3 (D) THE CONTACT PREFERENCE AND MEDICAL HISTORY FORMS DESCRIBED IN THIS  
4 SUBDIVISION ARE PRIVATE COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE BIRTH PARENT TO THE  
5 PERSON NAMED ON THE SEALED BIRTH CERTIFICATE AND NO COPIES OF SUCH FORMS  
6 SHALL BE RETAINED BY THE DEPARTMENT. WHERE ONLY A MEDICAL HISTORY FORM  
7 IS REQUESTED, THE CERTIFIED COPY OF THE LONG-FORM BIRTH CERTIFICATE AND  
8 CONTACT PREFERENCE FORMS SHALL NOT BE PROVIDED, BUT MAY BE REQUESTED AND  
9 PROVIDED AT A LATER DATE.

10 6. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP AN AFFIRMATIVE INFORMATION CAMPAIGN  
11 AND WIDELY DISSEMINATE TO THE PUBLIC, THROUGH ITS WEBSITE, PUBLIC SERVICE  
12 ANNOUNCEMENTS AND OTHER MEANS, IN MULTIPLE LANGUAGES AND THROUGH MULTI-  
13 PLE OUTLETS, INFORMATION CONCERNING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION,  
14 INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE MEANS BY WHICH A BIRTH PARENT MAY  
15 CONFIRM THAT HE OR SHE WISHES TO MAINTAIN THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF A  
16 LONG-FORM BIRTH CERTIFICATE HELD BY THE DEPARTMENT IN WHICH SUCH BIRTH  
17 PARENT IS NAMED, AND BY WHICH SUCH BIRTH PARENT MAY WITHDRAW SUCH A  
18 CONFIRMATION.

19 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-  
20 ing the date on which it shall have become a law, provided, however,  
21 that, effective immediately, the commissioner of health is directed to  
22 promulgate such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out  
23 the provisions of this act.
