AN ACT to amend the elder law, in relation to limiting the cost-sharing responsibilities of eligible participants in the elderly pharmaceutical insurance coverage program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 247 of the elder law is amended by adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:
  - 5. COST-SHARING RESPONSIBILITIES LIMIT. AT NO TIME DURING A COVERAGE PERIOD SHALL THE COST-SHARING RESPONSIBILITIES, WHICH ARE COMPRISED OF THE SUM OF THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE AND CO-PAYMENTS, EXCEED FIVE PERCENT OF THE ELIGIBLE PROGRAM PARTICIPANT'S GROSS INCOME, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
- 8 S 2. Section 248 of the elder law is amended by adding a new subdivi-9 sion 5 to read as follows:

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- 5. COST-SHARING RESPONSIBILITIES LIMIT. AT NO TIME DURING A COVERAGE PERIOD SHALL THE COST-SHARING RESPONSIBILITIES, WHICH ARE COMPRISED OF THE SUM OF THE ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLE AND CO-PAYMENTS, EXCEED FIVE PERCENT OF THE ELIGIBLE PROGRAM PARTICIPANT'S GROSS INCOME, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
- 14 S 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day next 15 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
