Section 1. Paragraph (f) of subdivision 2 of section 87 of the public 1 law, as amended by chapter 403 of the laws of 2003, is amended 2 officers 3 to read as follows: 4 (f) if disclosed could endanger the life or safety of any person, 5

UNLESS THE BENEFITS OF DISCLOSURE OUTWEIGH THE NEED FOR SECRECY;

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
