AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to authorizing public school principals and chief administrators to enroll academically low-performing students in after-school education programs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 815 to 2 read as follows:
 - read as follows:
 S 815. AUTHORIZATION TO ENROLL UNDER-PERFORMING STUDENTS IN ACADEMIC AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS. THE PRINCIPAL OR CHIEF ADMINISTRATOR OF EACH NEW
- 5 YORK STATE PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO ENROLL ANY STUDENT 6 ATTENDING SUCH SCHOOL AND PERFORMING BELOW ACADEMIC STANDARDS IN ANY
- 7 SUBJECT REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION IN AN AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM OFFERING
- 8 TRAINING OR TUTORING IN SUCH SUBJECT. SUCH AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM MAY BE
- 9 CONDUCTED ON SCHOOL PREMISES OR AT A NEIGHBORING SCHOOL OR OTHER NEIGH-
- 10 BORING EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES THAT CONDUCT ACADEMIC AFTER-SCHOOL
- 11 PROGRAMS APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER.

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12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
