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Introduced by M. of A. PRETLOW -- read once and referred to the Committee on Judiciary

AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to entitling senior citizens to a refund of the portion of a security deposit exceeding one month's rent

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The real property law is amended by adding a new section  
2 235-h to read as follows:  
3 S 235-H. SENIOR CITIZENS SECURITY DEPOSIT REFUND. NO LANDLORD MAY  
4 CHARGE MORE THAN THE EQUIVALENT OF ONE MONTH'S RENT AS A SECURITY DEPOSIT  
5 FOR RESIDENTIAL RENTAL PREMISES OCCUPIED BY ANY TENANT WHO HAS  
6 ATTAINED THE AGE OF SIXTY-TWO YEARS OR OLDER AND WHO HAS OCCUPIED SUCH  
7 RESIDENTIAL RENTAL PREMISES FOR FIVE OR MORE YEARS. UPON ATTAINING  
8 SIXTY-TWO YEARS OF AGE DURING THE TERM OF OCCUPANCY, ANY TENANT WHO  
9 NOTIFIES THE LANDLORD SHALL BE ENTITLED TO A REFUND OF THAT PORTION OF  
10 ANY SECURITY DEPOSIT HELD BY THE LANDLORD IN EXCESS OF ONE MONTH'S RENT.  
11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
