AN ACT to amend the legislative law, in relation to creation of the legislative budget office

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The legislative law is amended by adding a new article 5-C 1 2 to read as follows: 3

ARTICLE 5-C

LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE

SECTION 88-K. NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE.

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POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET 88-L. OFFICE.

8 NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE. S 88-K. THERE IS HEREBY 9 CREATED A NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE.

10 S 88-L. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET 1. THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE 11 OFFICE. SHALL PERFORM 12 BUDGET ANALYSIS TO DETERMINE THE FUNDING LEVELS NECESSARY TO THE OPERA-13 TION OF GOVERNMENTAL DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS AND RENDER ANTICIPATED 14 REVENUE ESTIMATES FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR. SUCH REVENUE ESTIMATES SHALL BE USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR PURPOSES OF DETERMINING BUDGET EXPENDITURES. 15

BUDGET 16 2. THE DIRECTOR OF THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE OFFICE SHALL 17 EXAMINE AND REVIEW ALL FINANCIAL INFORMATION OF THE STATE FOR THE 18 PURPOSE OF RENDERING REVENUE ESTIMATES USED IN DETERMINING WHETHER THE 19 PROPOSED STATE BUDGET IS BALANCED.

20 THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL BE HEADED BY A 3. DIRECTOR WHO SHALL BE APPOINTED BY A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE 21 AND 22 FOR A TERM OF FIVE YEARS. HE OR SHE SHALL DEVOTE HIS OR HER ASSEMBLY 23 FULL TIME AND EFFORT TO THE OFFICE OF DIRECTOR AND HE OR SHE SHALL HOLD 24 NO OTHER PUBLIC OFFICE. THE DIRECTOR SHALL RECEIVE SUCH COMPENSATION AS

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MAY BE FIXED BY THE OFFICE. THE DIRECTOR MAY APPOINT BUDGET ANALYSTS,
 ASSISTANTS AND SUCH OTHER EMPLOYEES AS HE OR SHE MAY DEEM NECESSARY OR
 DESIRABLE, PRESCRIBE THEIR DUTIES AND FIX THEIR COMPENSATION WITHIN THE
 AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED AND MADE AVAILABLE THEREFOR.

5 4. THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL BE CHARGED WITH 6 THE DUTY OF RENDERING ANTICIPATED REVENUE FORECAST REPORTS TO THE LEGIS-7 LATURE AND THE GOVERNOR FOR THE PURPOSES OF FACILITATING PASSAGE OF THE STATE BUDGET IN A TIMELY MANNER. THE DIRECTOR MAY REQUEST AND SHALL 8 RECEIVE FROM ALL PUBLIC OFFICERS, DEPARTMENTS, AGENCIES AND AUTHORITIES 9 10 OF THE STATE AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS, SUCH ASSISTANCE AND DATA AS SHALL BE NECESSARY TO PROJECT ANTICIPATED STATE REVENUES FOR BUDGETARY 11 12 PURPOSES.

13 5. THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL PROVIDE ASSISTANCE 14 IN DETERMINING THE FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION.

6. THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL SUBMIT TO THE
LEGISLATURE WRITTEN ESTIMATES OF ANTICIPATED STATE REVENUES ON JANUARY
FIFTEENTH, APRIL FIFTEENTH, JULY FIFTEENTH AND OCTOBER FIFTEENTH OF EACH
YEAR.

19 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
