AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to exemptions provided for possession and use of a pistol or revolver at certain pistol ranges

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph 7-e of subdivision a of section 265.20 of the  
2 penal law, as amended by chapter 281 of the laws of 2006, is amended to  
3 read as follows:  
4 7-e. Possession and use of a pistol or revolver, at an indoor or  
5 outdoor pistol range located in or on premises owned or occupied by a  
6 duly incorporated organization organized for conservation purposes or to  
7 foster proficiency in small arms or at a target pistol shooting competi-  
8 tion under the auspices of or approved by an association or organization  
9 described in paragraph 7-a of this subdivision for the purpose of load-  
10 ing and firing the same by a person at least fourteen years of age [but  
11 under the age of twenty-one] who has not been previously convicted of a  
12 felony or serious offense, and who does not appear to be, or pose a  
13 threat to be, a danger to himself or to others; provided however, that  
14 such possession shall be of a pistol or revolver duly licensed to and  
15 shall be used under the immediate supervision, guidance and instruction  
16 of, a person specified in paragraph seven of this subdivision.  
17 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
