AN ACT to amend the banking law, in relation to prohibiting banks from imposing surcharge fees at automated teller machines located at a state university or a city university

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The banking law is amended by adding a new section 9-v to 2 read as follows:
 - S 9-V. SPECIAL PROVISIONS RELATING TO AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE FEES.
- 4 1. A "BANKING INSTITUTION" FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION MEANS A BANK, 5 TRUST COMPANY, SAVINGS BANK, SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, LICENSED
- 6 FOREIGN BANK OR CREDIT UNION.
- 7 2. ALL BANKING INSTITUTIONS WHICH USE, OWN OR LEASE AUTOMATED TELLER 8 MACHINE FACILITIES LOCATED ON PROPERTY OWNED BY THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF 9 NEW YORK OR THE CITY UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK SHALL BE PROHIBITED FROM 10 CHARGING SURCHARGE FEES AT SUCH AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINES.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 12 have become a law.
