AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting the sale or use of styrofoam as a packaging material

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new section 27-0721 to read as follows:
 - S 27-0721. PROHIBITION ON USE OF STYROFOAM AS PACKAGING MATERIAL.

- 1. NO PERSON SHALL KNOWINGLY OFFER FOR SALE OR COMMERCIALLY USE STYRO-FOAM COMMONLY KNOWN AS "PACKING PEANUTS" AS A PACKAGING MATERIAL.
- 2. THE COMMISSIONER MAY ADOPT SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS AS ARE NECES-SARY AND APPROPRIATE TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION.
- 8 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 9 it shall have become a law; provided, however that the addition, amend-10 ment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implemen-11 tation of this act on its effective date are authorized and directed to 12 be made and completed on or before such date.
