AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to establishing a distinctive plate honoring the one hundredth anniversary of the Boy Scouts of America

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new section 404-x to read as follows:
  - S 404-X. DISTINCTIVE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA PLATES. 1. ANY PERSON RESIDING IN THIS STATE SHALL, UPON REQUEST, BE ISSUED A DISTINCTIVE PLATE HONORING THE ONE HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA OF A DESIGN APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER IN CONSULTATION WITH THE NATIONAL COUNCIL OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA.
- 2. AN APPLICATION FOR SUCH PLATE SHALL BE FILED WITH THE COMMISSIONER IN SUCH FORM AND DETAIL AS THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PRESCRIBE.
- 3. A DISTINCTIVE PLATE ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE ISSUED IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER NUMBER PLATES UPON PAYMENT OF THE REGULAR REGISTRATION FEE PRESCRIBED BY SECTION FOUR HUNDRED ONE OF THIS ARTICLE AND AN INITIAL ONE TIME SERVICE CHARGE OF TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS SHALL BE CHARGED FOR SUCH PLATES.
- 4. SUCH INITIAL SERVICE CHARGE SHALL BE DEPOSITED, PURSUANT TO SECTION 15 16 FOUR HUNDRED FOUR-OO OF THIS ARTICLE, TO THE CREDIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES DISTINCTIVE PLATE DEVELOPMENT FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 17 18 NINETY-FIVE-G OF THE STATE FINANCE LAW, AND SHALL BEUSED FOR THE 19 PRODUCTION, DESIGN, ADVERTISING AND MARKETING OF DISTINCTIVE PLATES
- 20 PURSUANT TO SUCH SECTION OF THE STATE FINANCE LAW; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, 21 THAT INITIAL SERVICE CHARGES COLLECTED IN EXCESS OF SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS
- 22 SHALL BE PAID ON A QUARTERLY BASIS TO THE NATIONAL COUNCIL OF THE BOY
- 23 SCOUTS OF AMERICA FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE WORLD FRIENDSHIP FUND OF THE BOY
- 24 SCOUTS OF AMERICA.
