AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to permitting a minor over eleven years of age to work as a referee for athletic games or competitions under certain circumstances

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 130 of the labor law is amended by 2 adding a new paragraph i to read as follows:
 - I. A MINOR OVER ELEVEN YEARS OF AGE AS A REFEREE AT AN ATHLETIC GAME, COMPETITION OR TOURNAMENT, INVOLVING COMPETITORS WHO ARE ELEVEN YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER, HOSTED BY AN ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION OR ORGANIZATION THAT
- 6 HAS TRAINED AND TESTED SUCH MINOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH ESTABLISHED SAFETY
- 7 STANDARDS, FOR A DURATION OF TWENTY HOURS OR LESS PER WEEK AND DURING 8 TIMES WHEN SCHOOL IS NOT IN SESSION.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
