AN ACT to amend the canal law and the public authorities law, in relation to local waterfront revitalization plans and programs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraphs a and c of subdivision 1 of section 138-a of the
2 canal law, as amended by chapter 243 of the laws of 1993, are amended to
3 read as follows:
4 a. the chairman of the authority, the commissioner of transportation,
5 the commissioner of the office of parks, recreation and historic preservation [and], the commissioner of environmental conservation AND THE
6 SECRETARY OF STATE, or their representatives;
7 c. the commissioner of economic development [and the secretary of
8 state,] or [their representatives] HIS OR HER REPRESENTATIVE, and a
9 member from each of the regional planning boards, as established by
10 articles five-G and twelve-B of the general municipal law, whose region
11 is intersected by the canal shall be ex-officio, non-voting members of
12 the commission and shall provide technical expertise and advice to the
13 commission as necessary.
14 S 2. Subdivision 4 of section 138-b of the canal law, as amended by
15 chapter 335 of the laws of 2001, is amended and a new subdivision 8 is
16 added to read as follows:
17 4. If deemed appropriate, request that studies, surveys or analyses be
18 performed by the corporation, the departments of transportation, econom-

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1 ic development [and], environmental conservation, STATE and/or the
2 office of parks, recreation and historic preservation to assist in the
3 development, promotion, marketing and/or preservation of the canal
4 system or the preparation of the plan. At the request of the commission,
5 state agencies and public authorities shall cooperate fully and shall
6 provide requested information in a timely manner.

7 8. ENCOURAGE LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO PREPARE LOCAL WATERFRONT REVITALIZA-
8 TION PROGRAMS AND PLANS PURSUANT TO ARTICLE FORTY-TWO OF THE EXECUTIVE
9 LAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF REFINING THE STATEWIDE CANAL RECREATIONWAY PLAN.
10 SUCH ENCOURAGEMENT MAY INCLUDE THE PROVISION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO
11 PREPARE AND IMPLEMENT SUCH PLANS AND PROGRAMS.

12 S 3. Subdivision 1 of section 384 of the public authorities law is
13 amended by adding a new paragraph (c) to read as follows:

14 (C) THE AUTHORITY IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
15 TO MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF UNDERTAKING THE PREPARATION AND
16 IMPLEMENTATION OF LOCAL WATERFRONT REVITALIZATION PLANS AND PROGRAMS.

17 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
