AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to the safe transfer, transport and storage of used mattresses for sale to commercial establishments

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 385-b to read as follows:

3 S 385-B. SAFE TRANSFER, TRANSPORT AND STORAGE OF USED BEDDING. 1. NO 4 USED BEDDING SHALL BE SOLD OR TRANSFERRED TO A COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT 5 UNLESS SUCH BEDDING HAS BEEN:

6 (A) SANITIZED USING A METHOD APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH THAT 7 IS INTENDED TO KILL BEDBUGS, DUST MITES, OTHER INSECTS, MOLDS, FUNGI, 8 GERMS OR OTHER ORGANISMS, AND TO REMOVE SOIL, DUST MITE AND INSECT 9 FECES, ALLERGENS AND OTHER CONTAMINANTS;

10 (B) IF A MATTRESS, TESTED AND CERTIFIED AS FULLY MEETING THE PRODUCT 11 PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THE MATTRESS FLAMMABILITY STAND-12 ARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE UNITED STATES CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY COMMISSION 13 AND CODIFIED AT 16 C.F.R. PARTS 1632 AND 1633 (INCLUDING ANY SUBSEQUENT 14 AMENDMENTS THERETO);

15 (C) PERMANENTLY LABELED WITH A YELLOW TAG STATING IN A CLEAR AND 16 CONSPICUOUS MANNER AND LOCATION THAT:

17 "THIS BEDDING CONTAINS PREVIOUSLY USED MATERIALS WHICH HAVE BEEN 18 CLEANED AND SANITIZED IN A REASONABLE MANNER TO KILL GERMS AND INSECTS 19 AND TO PREVENT INFECTION.";

20 (D) FOR MATTRESSES, SUCH TAG SHALL CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL 21 STATEMENT IN A CLEAR AND CONSPICUOUS MANNER AND LOCATION:

22 "THIS MATTRESS MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF 16 C.F.R. PARTS 1632 AND 23 1633 (CIGARETTE IGNITION AND OPEN FLAME) STANDARDS FOR MATTRESSES."; AND

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets
[] is old law to be omitted.

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(E) FOR ANY USED MATTRESSES AND BOX SPRING INTENDED FOR SALE OR TRANS-1 2 FER TO A COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT, THE TAG REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION 3 SHALL ALSO STATE IN A CLEAR AND CONSPICUOUS MANNER AND LOCATION: 4 "THIS LABEL MAY NOT BE REMOVED FOR ANY REASON AND MUST BE AVAILABLE 5 FOR INSPECTION BY THE GUESTS OF THIS ESTABLISHMENT." 6 2. NO COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT MAY PURCHASE OR OTHERWISE OBTAIN ANY 7 USED BEDDING THAT DOES NOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS PROVISION. 8 3. NO COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT THAT PURCHASES OR OTHERWISE OBTAINS ANY USED BEDDING THAT IS LABELED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION MAY REMOVE 9 10 SUCH LABEL AT ANY TIME. 11 4. ANY PERSON THAT SELLS OR OTHERWISE TRANSFERS OWNERSHIP OF USED 12 BEDDING TO A COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT SHALL: MAINTAIN FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST FIVE YEARS APPROPRIATE RECORDS 13 (A) 14 DOCUMENTING THE QUANTITY OF SUCH PRODUCTS IN QUESTION, THE NAME AND THE VENDOR AND RECIPIENT OF SUCH PRODUCTS, THE METHOD OF 15 ADDRESS OF DISPOSITION OF SUCH USED PRODUCTS, INCLUDING, AS RELEVANT, THE DISMANTL-16 ING, DESTRUCTION, SANITIZATION, AND LABELING OF SUCH PRODUCTS, 17 AND ALL TESTING AND OTHER RECORDS REQUIRED BY 16 C.F.R. PARTS 1632 AND 1633; AND 18 19 (B) MAKE SUCH RECORDS AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF 20 HEALTH UPON REOUEST. 21 5. NO PERSON ENGAGED IN THE SALE, DISTRIBUTION AND DELIVERY OR TRANS-22 PORT OF USED BEDDING TO OR FROM A COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT SHALL DELIVER TRANSPORT SUCH USED BEDDING IN PROXIMITY TO NEW BEDDING UNLESS SUCH 23 OR 24 USED BEDDING SHALL HAVE BEEN SANITIZED AS PROVIDED BY DEPARTMENT OF 25 HEALTH REGULATIONS. SUCH PROXIMITY SHALL INCLUDE IN THE SAME TRANSPORT 26 VEHICLE, UNLESS THE NEW BEDDING IS PACKAGED OR WRAPPED IN A SECURE 27 MANNER. 28 PERSON ENGAGED IN THE SALE OR DISTRIBUTION OF NEW OR USED 6. NO 29 BEDDING TO A COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT SHALL STORE USED BEDDING IN PROX-IMITY TO NEW BEDDING UNTIL SUCH USED BEDDING HAS BEEN THOROUGHLY SANI-30 TIZED IN ACCORDANCE WITH DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH REGULATIONS. 31 32 7. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION: 33 (A) "COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT" MEANS AN ESTABLISHMENT THAT PROVIDES OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATIONS TO THE PUBLIC INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, 34 HOTELS, MOTELS, INNS, LODGES, HOSTELS AND BED AND BREAKFASTS. 35 (B) "BEDDING" MEANS MATTRESSES AND BOX SPRINGS. 36 37 S 2. The department of health shall promulgate regulations for the 38 methods of sanitization to be used to kill bedbugs, dust mites, other 39 insects, molds, fungi, germs or other organisms, and the removal of 40 soil, dust mites and insect feces, allergens and other contaminants on or before the three hundred sixtieth day after the effective date of 41 42 this act. 43 S 3. This act shall take effect on the earliest of either: the thirti-44 eth day after regulations for sanitization, as provided in section two 45 of this act, have been finalized by the department of health; or on the three hundred ninetieth day after this act shall have become a law; 46 47 provided that the commissioner of health shall notify the legislative 48 bill drafting commission upon the occurrence of the enactment of the legislation provided for in this act in order that the commission may maintain an accurate and timely effective data base of the official text 49 50 51 the laws of the state of New York in furtherance of effectuating the of provisions of section 44 of the legislative law and section 70-b of the 52 53 public officers law.
