AN ACT to assign the late John Francis Covell to tier 4 status in the New York state teachers' retirement system as of the date of his death

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of law, John 1 2 Francis Covell, a deceased member of the New York state teachers' retirement system, shall be deemed to have had tier 4 status as a member 3 of said system on the date of his death. Said system shall recalculate 4 the benefits payable on account of his death and shall pay such benefits to his beneficiary as otherwise provided, less any amount already so 7 paid.

8 S 2. All costs attributable to the operation of this act shall be 9 borne by the employers of members of the New York state teachers' 10 retirement system.

S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

FISCAL NOTE. -- Pursuant to Legislative Law, Section 50:

This bill would allow Florence M. Covell, the widow of member John F. Covell who died in active service, to receive the Tier 4 active member death benefit. Ms. Covell received the lesser Tier 1 death benefit because her husband was a Tier 1 member of the New York State Teachers' Retirement System at the time of his death. He had recently completed а tier reinstatement from Tier 4 to Tier 1.

The cost for this benefit is equal to the increase in the present value of benefits, which is estimated to be \$94,000.

The source of this estimate is Fiscal Note 2011-11 dated March 8, 2011 prepared by the Actuary of the New York State Teachers' Retirement System and is intended for use only during the 2011 Legislative Session.
