AN ACT to amend the state administrative procedure act, in relation to improving the review of existing rules and agency outreach efforts

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 207 of the state administrative procedure act, as amended by chapter 327 of the laws of 2003, is amended and a new subdivision 6 is added to read as follows:

An agency shall submit for publication in the regulatory agenda 5 published in January pursuant to section two hundred two-d of this article a list of the rules which must be reviewed pursuant to subdivision one of this section in the ensuing calendar year. In addition to the 7 information required by such section two hundred two-d, for each rule so 9 listed the agency shall provide an analysis of the need for basis of such rule, shall invite public comment on the continuation or 10 modification of the rule and shall indicate the last date for submission 11 12 of comments which shall be not less than forty-five days from the AGENCY THAT PUBLISHES ITS REGULATORY AGENDA ON ITS 13 publication. AN14 WEBSITE SHALL ALSO PUBLISH THE LIST OF RULES THAT MUST BEREVIEWED SECTION ON ITS WEBSITE. ANY OTHER AGENCY MAY PUBLISH 15 PURSUANT TOTHIS SUCH LIST ON ITS WEBSITE. IF THE ORIGINAL NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE MAKING 16 17 FOR A LISTED RULE REQUIRED THE PREPARATION OF A REGULATORY FLEXIBILITY AND/OR A RURAL AREA FLEXIBILITY ANALYSIS, THE AGENCY SHALL SO 18 ANALYSIS PROVIDE OUTREACH 19 INDICATE AND SHALL AS APPROPRIATE TO POTENTIALLY 20 AFFECTED SMALL BUSINESSES, LOCAL GOVERNMENTS AND PUBLIC AND PRIVATE INTERESTS IN RURAL AREAS THAT THE RULE IS BEING REVIEWED. SUCH 21 OUTREACH SOLICITATION OF INPUT THROUGH ELECTRONIC MEANS OR THROUGH 22 INCLUDE 23 ANY OF THE ACTIVITIES LISTED IN SUBDIVISION SIX OF SECTION TWO HUNDRED 24 TWO-B AND SUBDIVISION SEVEN OF SECTION TWO HUNDRED TWO-BB OF THIS ARTI-

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6. THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF REGULATORY REFORM SHALL MONITOR AGENCY COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION AND SHALL MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO AGENCIES FOR IMPROVED COMPLIANCE AND FOR PROVIDING MORE EFFECTIVE OUTREACH TO SMALL BUSINESSES, LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, AND PUBLIC AND PRIVATE INTERESTS IN RURAL AREAS.

- S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 202-d of the state administrative procedure act is amended by adding a new paragraph (e) to read as follows:
- 8 (E) THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF REGULATORY REFORM SHALL MONITOR AGENCY 9 COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SECTION AND SHALL MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO AGENCIES 10 FOR IMPROVED COMPLIANCE AND FOR PROVIDING MORE EFFECTIVE OUTREACH TO 11 SMALL BUSINESSES, LOCAL GOVERNMENTS AND PUBLIC AND PRIVATE INTERESTS IN 12 RURAL AREAS.
- S 3. This act shall take effect on the first of December next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law; provided that the
 amendments to subdivision 1 of section 202-d of the state administrative
 procedure act, made by section two of this act, shall not affect the
 expiration of such subdivision pursuant to chapter 402 of the laws of
 18 1994, as amended, and shall expire therewith.
