- AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to providing certain school bus operators with a refund or credit of sales and compensating use taxes on the purchase of school buses and equipment and fuel used in the operation of a school bus

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 1119 of the tax law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision (f) to read as follows:

3 SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBDI-(F) 4 VISION, A REFUND OR CREDIT SHALL BE ALLOWED FOR TAX PAID PURSUANT ΤO 5 (A) OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED FIVE, PARAGRAPH THREE OF SUBDIVISION SUBDIVISION (C) OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED FIVE, OR SECTION ELEVEN 6 7 HUNDRED TEN OF THIS ARTICLE AND ANY TAX IMPOSED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORI-8 TY OF ARTICLE TWENTY-NINE OF THIS CHAPTER, ON THE SALE TO OR PURCHASE BY SCHOOL BUS OPERATOR OF (I) A SCHOOL BUS, AS DEFINED IN SECTION ONE 9 А HUNDRED FORTY-TWO OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW, AT LEAST 10 SEVENTY PERCENT OF THE USE OF WHICH IS FOR THE TRANSPORTATION, BY SUCH OPERATOR, 11 12 OF SCHOOL STUDENTS TO OR FROM SCHOOL OR SCHOOL RELATED EVENTS, PURSUANT TO A CONTRACT MADE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE EDUCATION LAW, (II) 13 14 PARTS, EQUIPMENT AND LUBRICANTS WHEN SUCH PARTS, EQUIPMENT AND LUBRI-CANTS ARE INSTALLED IN OR ON SUCH A SCHOOL BUS, AT LEAST SEVENTY PERCENT 15 OF THE USE OF WHICH IS FOR SUCH TRANSPORTATION, BY SUCH OPERATOR, PURSU-16 ANT TO SUCH CONTRACT, (III) THE SERVICES DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH THREE OF 17 18 SUBDIVISION (C) OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED FIVE OF THIS ARTICLE WHEN 19 RENDERED WITH RESPECT TO SUCH A SCHOOL BUS SO USED OR WITH RESPECT TO 20 PARTS, EOUIPMENT AND LUBRICANTS INSTALLED IN OR ON SUCH A SCHOOL BUS SO 21 USED, AND (IV) MOTOR FUEL OR DIESEL MOTOR FUEL USED EXCLUSIVELY BY SUCH

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OPERATOR IN SUCH A SCHOOL BUS FOR SUCH TRANSPORTATION PURSUANT TO 1 SUCH 2 NO REFUND OR CREDIT SHALL BE ALLOWED UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION CONTRACT. 3 UNLESS ALL OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR SUCH REFUND OR CREDIT HAVE BEEN MET A TWELVE MONTH PERIOD AFTER THE SCHOOL BUS OPERATOR'S 4 FOR AT LEAST 5 PURCHASE OF SUCH SCHOOL BUS; HOWEVER, SUCH REFUND OR CREDIT SHALL BE 6 ALLOWED FOR A SCHOOL BUS THAT IS PAINTED "NATIONAL SCHOOL BUS CHROME" 7 PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION TWENTY-ONE OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE 8 OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW AND LABELED AS A "SCHOOL BUS" PURSUANT TO SUBPARAGRAPH ONE OF PARAGRAPH (B) OF SUBDIVISION TWENTY OF SUCH SECTION 9 10 THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE IF ALL OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR SUCH REFUND OR 11 HAVE BEEN MET IN THE PREVIOUS QUARTERLY REPORTING PERIOD AS CREDIT DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (B) OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED 12 THIRTY-SIX OF AN APPLICATION FOR A REFUND OR CREDIT PURSUANT TO THIS 13 THIS ARTICLE. 14 SUBDIVISION MUST BE FILED WITH THE COMMISSIONER WITHIN THE TIME PROVIDED 15 BY SUBDIVISION (A) OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE OF THIS ARTICLE AND NO MORE FREQUENTLY THAN QUARTERLY. SUCH APPLICATION SHALL BE 16 IN SUCH FORM AS THE COMMISSIONER MAY PRESCRIBE. WHERE AN APPLICATION FOR 17 CREDIT HAS BEEN FILED, THE SCHOOL BUS OPERATOR MAY TAKE SUCH 18 CREDIT ON 19 THE RETURN WHICH IS DUE COINCIDENT WITH OR IMMEDIATELY SUBSEQUENT TO THE 20 THE SCHOOL BUS OPERATOR FILES SUCH APPLICATION FOR CREDIT. TIME HOWEV-21 ER, THE TAKING OF THE CREDIT ON THE RETURN SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE PART OF 22 THE APPLICATION FOR CREDIT AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS IN RESPECT TO APPLICATIONS FOR CREDIT IN SUCH SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED THIR-23 TY-NINE AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION (E) OF SUCH SECTION. 24 THE ALLOWANCE 25 OF THE CREDIT OR REFUND SHALL ALSO BE SUBJECT TO THE SCHOOL BUS OPERATOR 26 MAINTAINING RECORDS SATISFACTORY TO THE COMMISSIONER DEMONSTRATING COMPLIANCE WITH ALL THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBDIVISION. 27 THE PERCENT-OF SUCH SCHOOL BUS USE MAY BE COMPUTED EITHER ON THE BASIS OF MILE-28 AGE AGE OR HOURS OF USE, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PURCHASER OR USER. FOR THE 29 PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, THE TERM "SCHOOL" SHALL MEAN A PRE-KINDER-30 GARTEN OR KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM, A PRESCHOOL, NURSERY SCHOOL OR ELEMENTA-31 32 RY, INTERMEDIATE OR SECONDARY SCHOOL. THE REFUND OR CREDIT SHALL BE TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOU-33 SAND TWELVE AND ENDING AUGUST THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN, FIFTY 34 PERCENT FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN 35 THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN, SEVENTY-FIVE 36 AND ENDING AUGUST 37 PERCENT FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN AND ENDING AUGUST THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FIFTEEN AND ONE HUNDRED 38 PERCENT COMMENCING SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FIFTEEN. 39

40 This act shall take effect on the first day of the sales tax S 2. quarterly period, as described in subdivision (b) of section 1136 of the 41 tax law, next commencing September 1, 2012 and shall apply in accordance 42 43 with the applicable transitional provisions in sections 1106 and 1217 of 44 the tax law; provided, further, that the commissioner of taxation and 45 finance shall be authorized on and after the date this act shall have become a law to adopt and amend any rules or regulations and issue any 46 47 procedure, forms or instructions necessary to implement this act on its 48 effective date.
