AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to punishment for violations of the department of labor's fire regulations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 272 of the labor law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 8 to read as follows:
 - ANY PERSON ENTITY RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING A 8. VIOLATION. OR BUILDING SO AS TO AFFORD ADEOUATE PROTECTION AGAINST FIRE TO ALL PERSONS FOR THEREIN SHALL BE LIABLE FOR A PENALTY CIVIL ANY INTENTIONAL VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION. SUCH VIOLATION SHALL BE TRIABLE IN A PROCEEDING BEFORE A HEARING OFFICER OF THE DEPARTMENT CONVICTION OF A PERSON OR ENTITY, SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF
- 8 UPON CONVICTION OF A PERSON OR ENTITY, SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF 9 NO LESS THAN ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO MORE THAN FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS
- 10 FOR EACH VIOLATION. SUCH CIVIL PENALTY MAY BE RECOVERED IN AN ACTION OR
- 11 PROCEEDING IN ANY COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION.
- 12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
