Introduced by M. of A. JAFFEE -- read once and referred to the Committee  
on Real Property Taxation

AN ACT authorizing Kolllell Shas Keren Hatorah, Inc. to file an applica-  
tion for exemption from real property taxes for certain parcels of  
land located in the town of Ramapo, county of Rockland

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,  
2     the assessor of the town of Ramapo is hereby authorized to accept from  
3     Kolllell Shas Keren Hatorah, Inc., applications for exemption from real  
4     property taxes pursuant to section 420-a of the real property tax law  
5     for the 2008 assessment roll, for the parcels owned by such organization  
6     located in the town of Ramapo at 9 and 11 Weiner Dr., Monsey, identified  
7     as section 49.15, block 2, lots 50.1 and 50.2. If accepted, the applica-  
8     tions shall be reviewed as if they had been received on or before the  
9     taxable status date established for such roll.  
10    If satisfied that such not-for-profit corporation would otherwise be  
11    entitled to such exemptions if the organization had filed applications  
12    for such exemption by the appropriate taxable status date, the assessor  
13    of the town of Ramapo, upon approval by the town of Ramapo town board,  
14    may grant exemption from taxation with respect to the subject roll and  
15    make appropriate correction to the subject roll. If the exemption is  
16    granted and such not-for-profit corporation shall have paid any tax with  
17    regard to the subject roll, the town of Ramapo town board may, in its  
18    sole discretion, provide for the refund of those taxes paid and cancel  
19    taxes, fines, penalties, liens or interest remaining unpaid.  
20    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
