AN ACT in relation to dissolving the village of Medina housing authority  
and the village of Medina urban renewal agency; and to repeal title  
124 of article 13 of the public housing law and title 88 of article  
15-B of the general municipal law relating thereto

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     Section 1. Title 124 of article 13 of the public housing law is  
2     REPEALED.
- 3     S 2. The powers, duties and unfinished business of the village of  
4     Medina housing authority are transferred to the village of Medina, coun-  
5     ty of Orleans. All assets, liabilities and records of the village of  
6     Medina housing authority are transferred to such village. For the  
7     purpose of succession to functions, powers, duties and obligations  
8     transferred and assigned to, devolved upon and assumed by it pursuant to  
9     this act, such village shall be deemed and held to constitute the  
10    continuation of the village of Medina housing authority.
- 11    S 3. Title 88 of article 15-B of the general municipal law is  
12    REPEALED.
- 13    S 4. The powers, duties and unfinished business of the village of  
14    Medina urban renewal agency are transferred to the village of Medina,  
15    county of Orleans. All assets, liabilities and records of the village of  
16    Medina urban renewal agency are transferred to such village. For the  
17    purpose of succession to functions, powers, duties and obligations  
18    transferred and assigned to, devolved upon and assumed by it pursuant to  
19    this act, such village shall be deemed and held to constitute the  
20    continuation of village of Medina urban renewal agency.
- 21    S 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
