AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to qualifications of bus drivers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 509-d of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:

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3 (2-A) INVESTIGATIONS AND INQUIRIES OF BUS DRIVERS OTHER THAN SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS. (A) A MOTOR CARRIER SHALL REQUEST THE DEPARTMENT TO 4 INITI-5 ATE A CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK FOR PERSONS HIRED OR RE-HIRED BY SUCH MOTOR 6 CARRIER ON OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBDIVISION AS DRIVERS OF BUSES, AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH (B), (C), (D) OR (E) OF SUBDIVISION ONE 7 8 OF SECTION FIVE HUNDRED NINE-A OF THIS ARTICLE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGU-9 LATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER REOUIRING SUCH BUS DRIVERS TO SUBMIT TO THE MANDATED FINGERPRINTING PROCEDURE. ADDITIONALLY, FOR DRIVERS OF BUSES, 10 AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH (B), (C), (D) OR (E) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION FIVE HUNDRED NINE-A OF THIS ARTICLE, IN THE EMPLOY OF A MOTOR 11 12 CARRIER ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBDIVISION, 13 THE MOTOR CARRIER SHALL REQUEST ON OR BEFORE THE TIME OF ANY SUCH DRIVER'S FIRST RENEWAL 14 OF LICENSE PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION SIX OF SECTION FIVE HUNDRED 15 TWO OF 16 THIS TITLE THAT THE DEPARTMENT INITIATE A CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK IN 17 ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER. THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES AT THE REQUEST OF THE MOTOR CARRIER SHALL INITIATE A 18 19 CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK OF ALL BUS DRIVERS HIRED OR RE-HIRED ON OR AFTER 20 THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBDIVISION AND ALL CURRENT BUS DRIVERS ON OR TIME OF THEIR FIRST RENEWAL OF LICENSE BY REQUIRING SUCH 21 BEFORE THE 22 APPLICANTS TO SUBMIT TO THE MANDATED FINGERPRINTING PROCEDURE AS PART OF 23 THE BUS DRIVER QUALIFICATION PROCEDURE. SUCH FINGERPRINTING PROCEDURE 24 AND THE RELATED FEE AS WELL AS A PROCEDURE FOR THE RETURN OF SUCH FING-25 ERPRINTS UPON APPLICATION OF A PERSON WHO HAS TERMINATED EMPLOYMENT AS A

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BUS DRIVER SHALL BE ESTABLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS 1 OF THE 2 IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DIVISION OF COMMISSIONER 3 CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES. THE FEE TO BE PAID BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE 4 APPLICANT OR BUS DRIVER SHALL BE NO MORE THAN FIVE DOLLARS OVER THE COST 5 COMMISSIONER FOR THE CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK. NO CAUSE OF ACTION ΤO THE 6 AGAINST THE DEPARTMENT, THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES, Α 7 MOTOR CARRIER OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION FOR DAMAGES RELATED TO THE 8 DISSEMINATION OF CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL EXIST WHEN SUCH DEPARTMENT, DIVISION, MOTOR CARRIER OR POLITICAL SUBDI-9 10 VISION HAS REASONABLY AND IN GOOD FAITH RELIED UPON THE ACCURACY AND COMPLETENESS OF CRIMINAL HISTORY INFORMATION FURNISHED TO IT 11 ΒY OUALI-12 FINGERPRINTS SUBMITTED TO THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL FIED AGENCIES. JUSTICE SERVICES PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION MAY ALSO BE 13 SUBMITTED TΟ 14 THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION FOR A NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY 15 RECORD CHECK. NOTWITHSTANDING THE FOREGOING, THE DEPARTMENT MAY ΒY REGULATION ESTABLISH GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES FOR EXEMPTING BUS DRIVERS 16 17 HAVE ALREADY BEEN SUBJECTED TO A CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK AT THE TIME WHO 18 OF HIRE BY A MOTOR CARRIER.

(B) AFTER A MOTOR CARRIER HAS COMPLETED THE PROCEDURES 19 SET FORTH IN 20 PARAGRAPH (A) THIS OF SUBDIVISION, IT SHALL DESIGNATE EACH NEW BUS DRIV-21 ER AS A CONDITIONAL BUS DRIVER AS DEFINED IN SECTION FIVE HUNDRED NINE-H 22 THIS ARTICLE, UNTIL THE CARRIER IS IN RECEIPT OF INFORMATION OF THE OF 23 NEW BUS DRIVER'S QUALIFICATION FROM THE DEPARTMENT AND THE REQUIRED DRIVING RECORDS FROM EACH APPROPRIATE STATE AGENCY. IF THE INFORMATION 24 25 RECEIVED INDICATES THAT THERE IS A PENDING CRIMINAL OFFENSE OR DRIVING 26 VIOLATION THAT WOULD REQUIRE DISQUALIFICATION OF A BUS DRIVER UNDER THIS THE APPLICANT TO PROVIDE 27 THE MOTOR CARRIER SHALL REQUIRE ARTICLE, 28 DOCUMENTATION EVIDENCING THE DISPOSITION OF SUCH OFFENSE OR VIOLATION IN 29 ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSIONER. THE DEPART-MENT, UPON NOTICE OF DISQUALIFICATION TO AN APPLICANT, SHALL INCLUDE 30 IN SUCH NOTICE INFORMATION REGARDING THE APPLICANT'S RIGHT TO APPEAL AND 31 CONTEST ANY CLAIMED GROUND FOR DISQUALIFICATION. SUCH NOTICE SHALL ALSO 32 33 ADVISE THE APPLICANT OF HIS OR HER RIGHT TO OBTAIN, EXAMINE, INSPECT AND INFORMATION USED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN SUPPORT OF ITS DETERMI-34 COPY ANY NATION OF DISQUALIFICATION. IN THE EVENT THE APPLICANT CONTESTS 35 THE OF A CRIMINAL CONVICTION IN HIS OR HER NAME, SUCH APPLICANT 36 EXISTENCE 37 MAY PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION EVIDENCING THE DISPOSITION OF SUCH OFFENSE OR 38 VIOLATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION-39 ER.

S 2. Section 509-h of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chap-41 ter 675 of the laws of 1985, is amended to read as follows:

S 509-h. Operation by person not [licensed] QUALIFIED to drive a bus. 42 43 The motor carrier shall not knowingly permit any person to operate a bus carrying passengers unless the driver meets all of the requirements of 44 45 this article; except that a motor carrier may permit a conditional BUS DRIVER OR CONDITIONAL school bus driver who is not otherwise disquali-46 47 fied under the provisions of this article to operate a bus for a period 48 not to exceed ninety days or a longer period if granted a written extension of such ninety day period by the department pursuant to regulations established by the commissioner. Such regulation shall authorize exten-49 50 sion for at least that period of time necessary to review information 51 regarding the prior criminal history of the applicant. 52

53 S 3. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new section 54 509-hh to read as follows:

55 S 509-HH. DUTY OF CERTAIN MOTOR CARRIERS TO SUPPLY IDENTIFYING INFOR-56 MATION AND BUS REGISTRATION INFORMATION TO THE DEPARTMENT; REQUIREMENTS

REGARDING CERTAIN BUS REGISTRATIONS AND REGISTRATIONS. 1. EXCEPT AS 1 2 OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBDIVISION, EVERY MOTOR CARRIER MUST PROVIDE 3 THE DEPARTMENT IDENTIFYING INFORMATION AND BUS REGISTRATION INFORMA-TO 4 TION ON A FORM OR FORMS PREPARED AND FURNISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR 5 THAT PURPOSE. IDENTIFYING INFORMATION SHALL INCLUDE, BUT SHALL NOT BE 6 LIMITED TO, INFORMATION REGARDING: THE BUSINESS NAME, OWNERSHIP, BUSI-7 NESS ADDRESS, AND FEDERAL OR STATE IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS OF THE MOTOR 8 CARRIER. BUS REGISTRATION INFORMATION SHALL INCLUDE, BUT SHALL NOT BE LIMITED TO, INFORMATION REASONABLY REQUIRED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN CARRY-9 10 OUT ITS DUTIES UNDER THIS ARTICLE REGARDING THE REGISTRATION OF ING BUSES OWNED, LEASED, RENTED, OR OTHERWISE CONTROLLED BY THE MOTOR CARRI-11 12 IDENTIFYING INFORMATION AND BUS REGISTRATION INFORMATION ER. MUST ACCOMPANIED BY SUCH SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION AS MAY BE 13 CONTAIN OR BE 14 REQUESTED OR REQUIRED BY THE DEPARTMENT. A MOTOR CARRIER MUST NOTIFY THE 15 DEPARTMENT IN WRITING OF ANY CHANGE IN ANY INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE 16 MOTOR CARRIER TO THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION WITHIN TEN DAYS 17 OF THE CHANGE.

NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, ON AND AFTER 18 2. 19 THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, ANY MOTOR CARRIER SUBJECT ΤO THIS SECTION REGISTERING OR RE-REGISTERING A BUS UNDER THIS ARTICLE SHALL 20 21 REGISTER OR RE-REGISTER THE BUS ONLY IN THE SAME BUSINESS NAME THAT THE 22 CARRIER PROVIDES TO THE DEPARTMENT UNDER SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS 23 SECTION.

3. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "MOTOR CARRIER" SHALL NOT INCLUDE (A) A STATE, LOCAL, INTERSTATE OR INTERNATIONAL AUTHORITY AS DEFINED IN SECTION TWO OF THE PUBLIC AUTHORITIES LAW, OR (B) A SCHOOL INSTRICT AS DEFINED IN SECTION NINETEEN HUNDRED EIGHTY OF THE EDUCATION LAW.

29 S 4. Subdivision 5 of section 509-m of the vehicle and traffic law, as 30 added by chapter 675 of the laws of 1985, is amended to read as follows: 5. Upon receipt of the criminal history record report of [a school] 31 32 ANY bus driver, notify the motor carrier of disqualification of an 33 applicant or [school] bus driver which would or could disqualify such driver under the provisions of section FIVE HUNDRED NINE-C OR five hundred nine-cc of this article. Notification to the carrier shall be 34 35 without specification of the grounds for disqualification, those grounds 36 37 to be made available only to the [school] bus driver or his or her 38 representative.

39 S 5. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 40 have become a law.
