AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to authorizing the release of certain records of deceased residents of OPWDD operated or certified facilities to family members upon written request

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision (f) of section 13.09 of the mental hygiene law is relettered subdivision (h) and a new subdivision (f) is added to read as follows:

(F) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 33.13 AND 33.16 OF THIS CHAPTER, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROMULGATE REGULATIONS TO AUTHORIZE, WRITTEN REQUEST AND AS DETERMINED ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS, THE 7 RELEASE OF CERTAIN RECORDS PERTAINING TO A DECEASED INDIVIDUAL IN A FACILITY OPERATED OR CERTIFIED BY THE OFFICE. THE REGU-9 LATIONS SHALL SPECIFY WHICH INFORMATION MAY BE RELEASED AND SHALL INCLUDE CONSIDERATION OF INFORMATION AS THE INDIVIDUAL'S NAME; 10 SUCH DATES OF ADMISSION, DISCHARGE, BIRTH AND DEATH; CAUSE OF DEATH; A SUMMA-11 RY OF THE DIAGNOSIS, TREATMENT, AND SERVICES PROVIDED; EMPLOYMENT; RESI-12 13 DENTIAL AND FAMILY HISTORY; AND OTHER IDENTIFYING DATA. THE REGULATIONS 14 SHALL SPECIFY THE CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH SUCH RECORDS 15 RELEASED AND SHALL INCLUDE CONSIDERATION OF THE NEED OF A FAMILY MEMBER 16 OTHER THAN A QUALIFIED PERSON AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH SIX OF SUBDIVISION (A) OF SECTION 33.16 OF THIS CHAPTER TO ACCESS INFORMATION. IN THE EVENT 17 18 THE DECEASED INDIVIDUAL, OR IN THE CASE OF ANINDIVIDUAL WHO LACKED TO CONSENT TO THE RELEASE OF HIS OR HER RECORDS, A QUALIFIED 19 CAPACITY PERSON AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH SIX OF SUBDIVISION (A) OF 20 SECTION CHAPTER, HAD PREVIOUSLY OBJECTED TO THE RELEASE OF HIS OR HER 21 22 RECORDS AND SUCH OBJECTION WAS IN WRITING OR OTHERWISE DOCUMENTED IN THE

23 INDIVIDUAL'S SERVICES PLAN AND HAD NOT BEEN WITHDRAWN, THE COMMISSIONER 24 SHALL NOT AUTHORIZE THE RELEASE OF SUCH RECORDS.

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S 2. Subdivision (c) of section 33.13 of the mental hygiene law is

- amended by adding a new paragraph 15 to read as follows:

 15. UPON WRITTEN REQUEST TO THE PHYSICIAN OF A FAMILY MEMBER OF A DECEASED INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS A DEMONSTRABLE MEDICAL NEED FOR SUCH INFOR-MATION AS IT IS RELEVANT TO THE FAMILY MEMBER'S OWN HEALTH CARE.
- S 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided that section one of this act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after it shall have become a law.
