AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring school districts to distribute to students in each school building written information about the public library and how to obtain a library card

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 815 to  
2     read as follows:  
3     S 815. DISTRIBUTION OF PUBLIC LIBRARY CARD APPLICATION MATERIALS. 1.  
4     DEFINITIONS. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING TERMS SHALL  
5     BE DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:  
6     A. "SCHOOL DISTRICT" SHALL MEAN ANY PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE  
7     STATE OF NEW YORK THAT CONTAINS ONE OR MORE SCHOOLS WITH ANY COMBINATION  
8     OF GRADES FROM AND INCLUDING KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE TWELVE WHICH IS  
9     LOCATED OUTSIDE OF NEW YORK CITY.  
10    B. "PUBLIC LIBRARY" SHALL MEAN ANY PUBLIC OR ASSOCIATION LIBRARY AS  
11    DEFINED IN SECTION TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE OF THIS TITLE WHICH IS LOCATED  
12    OUTSIDE OF NEW YORK CITY.  
13    2. EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL BE REQUIRED TO DISSEMINATE INFORMATIONAL  
14    MATERIALS ABOUT THE PUBLIC LIBRARY AND APPLICATIONS FOR PUBLIC LIBRARY  
15    CARDS TO STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:  
16    A. ANNUALLY TO EVERY STUDENT OF SUCH SCHOOL DISTRICT UPON HIS OR HER  
17    ENTRY INTO KINDERGARTEN, GRADE SIX AND GRADE NINE;  
18    B. TO EVERY STUDENT UPON HIS OR HER ENROLLMENT AS A NEW STUDENT; AND  
19    C. AVAILABLE AT ALL TIMES IN THE SCHOOL LIBRARY IN EACH SCHOOL WITHIN  
20    THE SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS WHO WISH TO OBTAIN SUCH  
21    MATERIALS.  
22    3. EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL CONSULT ANNUALLY WITH THE DIRECTOR OF  
23    EACH PUBLIC LIBRARY LOCATED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT

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1 IN ORDER TO REQUEST COPIES OF MATERIALS CONTAINING INFORMATION REGARDING  
2 THE LIBRARY, INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW STUDENTS MAY OBTAIN A LIBRARY CARD AND  
3 AN APPLICATION FOR A LIBRARY CARD.

4 4. EACH PUBLIC LIBRARY THAT IS LOCATED IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL  
5 PROVIDE SUFFICIENT COPIES OF SUCH MATERIALS TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR  
6 DISTRIBUTION AS DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION SO THAT  
7 EACH SCHOOL MAY SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

8 5. IN THE EVENT THERE IS NO PUBLIC LIBRARY LOCATED WITHIN THE BOUNDA-  
9 RIES OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT, SUCH SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO  
10 COMPLY WITH THIS SECTION.

11 6. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH RULES AND  
12 REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

13 7. NOTHING IN THIS ACT SHALL REQUIRE A SCHOOL DISTRICT TO EXPEND ADDI-  
14 TIONAL FUNDS IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

15 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of September next  
16 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
