Introduced by M. of A. KELLNER -- read once and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to contributions to the animal population control fund

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 209-h to
2 read as follows:
- 3 S 209-H. GIFTS FOR THE ANIMAL POPULATION CONTROL FUND. EFFECTIVE FOR
4 ANY TAX YEAR COMMENCING ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TWELVE,
5 A TAXPAYER IN ANY TAXABLE YEAR MAY ELECT TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE SUPPORT OF
6 THE ANIMAL POPULATION CONTROL FUND. SUCH CONTRIBUTION SHALL BE IN ANY
7 WHOLE DOLLAR AMOUNT AND SHALL NOT REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF STATE TAX OWED BY
8 SUCH TAXPAYER. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL INCLUDE SPACE ON THE CORPORATE
9 INCOME TAX RETURN TO ENABLE A TAXPAYER TO MAKE SUCH CONTRIBUTION.
10 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, ALL REVENUES COLLECTED
11 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE ANIMAL POPULATION
12 CONTROL FUND AND SHALL BE USED ONLY FOR THOSE PURPOSES ENUMERATED IN
13 SECTION NINETY-SEVEN-XX OF THE STATE FINANCE LAW.
- 14 S 2. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 630-c to read as
15 follows:
- 16 S 630-C. GIFTS FOR ANIMAL POPULATION CONTROL FUND. EFFECTIVE FOR ANY
17 TAX YEAR COMMENCING ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TWELVE, AN
18 INDIVIDUAL IN ANY TAXABLE YEAR MAY ELECT TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE ANIMAL
19 POPULATION CONTROL FUND. SUCH CONTRIBUTION SHALL BE IN ANY WHOLE DOLLAR
20 AMOUNT AND SHALL NOT REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF STATE TAX OWED BY SUCH INDIVIDUAL.
21 THE COMMISSIONER SHALL INCLUDE SPACE ON THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX
22 RETURN TO ENABLE THE TAXPAYER TO MAKE SUCH CONTRIBUTION. NOTWITHSTANDING
23 ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, ALL REVENUES COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS
24 SECTION SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE ANIMAL POPULATION CONTROL FUND AND USED
25 ONLY FOR THOSE PURPOSES ENUMERATED IN SECTION NINETY-SEVEN-XX OF THE
26 STATE FINANCE LAW.
- 27 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
