AN ACT to amend the multiple dwelling law, in relation to permitted obstructions in a city with a population of one million or more

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 9 of section 26 of the multiple dwelling law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph m to read as follows:

3 IN A CITY WITH A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE, THE AREA OF YARDS, REAR YARD EQUIVALENTS, COURTS OR OPEN SPACES REQUIRED 5 SECTION, SECTION ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO OR SECTION TWO HUNDRED TWELVE OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL NOT BE DEEMED TO BE REDUCED OR OBSTRUCTED BY EXTE-6 7 RIOR WALL THICKNESS OF UP TO EIGHT INCHES ADDED TO THEEXTERIOR OF A TO ACCOMMODATE THE ADDITION OF INSULATION TO THE EXTENT THAT 9 SUCH EXTERIOR WALL THICKNESS IS A PERMITTED OBSTRUCTION FOR SUCH BUILD-10 ING UNDER THE ZONING RESOLUTION OF SUCH CITY.

11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
