AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to the powers and duties of the superintendent of insurance

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The insurance law is amended by adding a new section 215 to 2 read as follows:
- 215. SUPERINTENDENT TO PROHIBIT RETROACTIVE APPLICATIONS RESULTING RATE CHANGE. THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL PROMULGATE RULES AND PROHIBIT RETROACTIVE APPLICATIONS OF A RESULTING RATE REGULATIONS TO CHANGE. SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, 7 ESTABLISHING REASONABLE TIME PERIODS IN WHICH THE DEPARTMENT REVIEW RATE REQUESTS AND PROVIDING THE DEPARTMENT WITH SUFFICIENT 9 RESOURCES TO ACCOMPLISH SUCH TASKS.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 10
