AN ACT to amend the state law, in relation to designating black dirt as the state soil and to designate the black dirt region as home to the most fertile soil

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The state law is amended by adding a new section 89 to
2 read as follows:

3 S 89. STATE SOIL. BLACK DIRT SHALL BE THE OFFICIAL SOIL OF THE STATE
4 OF NEW YORK AND THE BLACK DIRT REGION LOCATED IN SOUTHERN ORANGE COUNTY
5 SHALL BE THE OFFICIAL HOME OF THE MOST FERTILE SOIL IN THE STATE OF NEW
6 YORK.

7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
