AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to including within the offense of promoting prostitution in the first degree, the prostitution of a child by a parent, guardian or person charged with the care and custody of the child

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 230.32 of the penal law, as added by chapter 627 of 2 the laws of 1978, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 S 230.32 Promoting prostitution in the first degree.
- A person is guilty of promoting prostitution in the first degree when [he]:
- 6 1. HE OR SHE knowingly advances or profits from prostitution of a 7 [person] CHILD less than eleven years old[.]; OR
- 8 2. BEING THE PARENT, GUARDIAN OR OTHER PERSON LEGALLY CHARGED WITH THE 9 CARE AND CUSTODY OF A CHILD LESS THAN SEVENTEEN YEARS OLD, HE OR SHE 10 KNOWINGLY ADVANCES OR PROFITS FROM PROSTITUTION OF SUCH CHILD.
- 11 Promoting prostitution in the first degree is a class B felony.
- 12 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-13 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
