AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to requiring employees who provide respite care services to be certified in first aid and CPR/AED

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section
2 7.45 to read as follows:
3 S 7.45 RESPITE CARE; FIRST AID AND CPR/AED TRAINING.
4 (A) FOR PURPOSES OF THE SECTION, THE TERM "RESPITE CARE" SHALL MEAN
5 THE PROVISION OF INTERMITTENT TEMPORARY SUBSTITUTE CARE OF A PERSON WITH
6 MENTAL ILLNESS ON BEHALF OF AND IN THE ABSENCE OF THE PARENT OR LEGAL
7 GUARDIAN OF SUCH PERSON, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING RELIEF FROM THE
8 STRESSES OF RESPONSIBILITIES OF PROVIDING CONTINUED CARE.
9 (B) EVERY EMPLOYEE OF THE OFFICE WHOSE PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY IS TO
10 PROVIDE RESPITE CARE SERVICES TO MENTALLY ILL PERSONS AND THEIR FAMILIES
11 SHALL BE CERTIFIED IN FIRST AID AND CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION
12 (CRP)/AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR USE (AED) WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF
13 THE HIRING OF SUCH EMPLOYEE AND EVERY TWO YEARS THEREAFTER. THE EXPENSE
14 OF SUCH TRAINING SHALL BE BORNE BY THE DEPARTMENT.
15 (C) THE OFFICE IS AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PROMULGATE RULES AND
16 REGULATIONS NECESSARY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION.
17 S 2. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section 13.41
18 to read as follows:
19 S 13.41 RESPITE CARE; FIRST AID AND CPR/AED TRAINING.
20 (A) FOR PURPOSES OF THE SECTION, THE TERM "RESPITE CARE" SHALL MEAN
21 THE PROVISION OF INTERMITTENT TEMPORARY SUBSTITUTE CARE OF A PERSON WITH
22 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ON BEHALF OF AND IN THE ABSENCE OF THE PARENT
23 OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF SUCH PERSON, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING RELIEF
24 FROM THE STRESSES OF RESPONSIBILITIES OF PROVIDING CONTINUED CARE.
25 (B) EVERY EMPLOYEE OF THE OFFICE WHOSE PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY IS TO
26 PROVIDE RESPITE CARE SERVICES TO PERSONS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES
27 AND THEIR FAMILIES SHALL BE CERTIFIED IN FIRST AID AND CARDIOPULMONARY

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1 RESUSCITATION (CPR)/AUTOMATE EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR USE (AED) WITHIN SIX
2 MONTHS OF THE HIRING OF SUCH EMPLOYEE AND EVERY TWO YEARS THEREAFTER.
3 THE EXPENSE OF SUCH TRAINING SHALL BE BORNE BY THE DEPARTMENT.
4 (C) THE OFFICE IS AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PROMULGATE RULES AND
5 REGULATIONS NECESSARY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION.
6 S 3. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall
7 have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediately, the
8 addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary
9 for the implementation of this act on its effective date is authorized
10 to be made and completed on or before such date.
