AN ACT to amend the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, in relation to prohibiting certain claims from being finalized in claiming races

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law is 2 amended by adding a new section 104-c to read as follows:

S 104-C. PROHIBITION AGAINST FINALIZING CERTAIN CLAIMS IN CLAIMING RACES. NO CLAIM FOR A HORSE IN A CLAIMING RACE SHALL BE FINALIZED, UNLESS SUCH HORSE FINISHES THE RACE UNASSISTED AND IS EXAMINED BY A VETERINARIAN, LICENSED TO PRACTICE VETERINARY MEDICINE IN THIS STATE PURSUANT TO ARTICLE ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE OF THE EDUCATION LAW.

This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 9 it shall have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediate-10 ly, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation 11 necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are 12 authorized to be made on or before such effective date.
