AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to requiring the commissioner of temporary and disability assistance to submit an annual report detailing local social services districts efforts to prevent, identify, and address homelessness

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (d) of section 17 of the social services law, 2 as amended by chapter 749 of the laws of 1989, is amended to read as 3 follows:

4 (d) submit an annual report to the governor and the legislature prior 5 to the fifteenth day of December of each year. Such annual report shall б include the following: the affairs of the department and the status of welfare programs in the state with recommendations for the 7 improvement 8 development of welfare programs; a report on the department's fair and 9 hearing system, as required by section twenty-two of this article; a written evaluation report on the delivery of child welfare services in 10 the state, as required by subdivision five of section four hundred seven 11 12 of this chapter; a report of the operations of the state central regis-13 ter of child abuse and maltreatment and the various local child protec-14 tive services, as required by section four hundred twenty-six of this chapter; a report on the number and status and the findings of investi-15 gations of deaths of children pursuant to subdivision five of 16 section 17 twenty of this chapter; a report on the progress of the development and 18 operation of the child care review system, as required by subdivision 19 nine of section four hundred forty-two of this chapter; commencing 20 before December fifteenth, nineteen hundred eighty-four and terminating 21 on December fifteenth, nineteen hundred eighty-nine, a progress report 22 on the planning and implementation of the teenage services act as 23 required by the provisions of section four hundred nine-m of [title 24 four-B of] this chapter; an analysis of the information contained in the 25 registry of community facilities, as required by paragraph (b) of subdi-26 vision two of section four hundred sixty-three-a of this chapter; [and]

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1 a report on the operation of the child support enforcement program, as 2 required by chapter six hundred eighty-five of the laws of nineteen 3 hundred seventy-five; AND A REPORT OF THE EFFORTS OF EACH LOCAL SOCIAL 4 SERVICES DISTRICT TO IDENTIFY, PREVENT, AND ADDRESS THEIR HOMELESS POPU-5 LATION, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO PROJECTS FUNDED BY FEDERAL, STATE, 6 MUNICIPAL, OR PRIVATE DOLLARS;

7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
