WHEREAS, Judge Kane was then elected to the Sullivan County Family Court; in 1992, he was elected as Sullivan County Judge and Surrogate, and was also elected to the Supreme Court of the State of New York in 1995; and

WHEREAS, Judge Kane served as the resident Supreme Court Justice in Sullivan County from January of 1996 until his appointment to the Appellate Division; and

WHEREAS, True assets to society, Judge Anthony and Nancy Kane have worked tirelessly as members of Hospice of Orange and Sullivan Counties, Inc.; their dedication is cherished as they have organized an annual 5k run/walk for the past several years; and
