AN ACT to amend the town law, in relation to providing for the election of a third town justice in the town of Guilderland in the county of Albany

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 20 of the town law is amended by 2 adding a new paragraph (m) to read as follows:
- (M) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF ANY GENERAL, SPECIAL OR LOCAL TO THE CONTRARY, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF GUILDERLAND, COUNTY OF ALBANY MAY ADOPT A RESOLUTION, SUBJECT TO A PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM AS PROVIDED BY ARTICLE SEVEN OF THIS CHAPTER, AT LEAST SIXTY DAYS PRIOR TO ANY REGULAR OR SPECIAL ELECTION DETERMINING THAT SUCH TOWN SHALL JUSTICES. IF THE TOWN BOARD OF SUCH TOWN SHALL HAVE ADOPTED SUCH A RESOLUTION AND NO PETITION SHALL HAVE BEEN FILED WITHIN THE A REFERENDUM THEREON, OR IF A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST ON ANY SUCH PROPOSITION SUBMITTED TO THE VOTE OF THE ELECTORS BE IN 11 12 AFFIRMATIVE, THE ELECTORS OF SUCH TOWN SHALL ELECT AT THE SUCCEEDING
- GENERAL ELECTION A TOWN JUSTICE WHO SHALL TAKE OFFICE FOR A TERM OF FOUR 13 14 YEARS BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY NEXT SUCCEEDING SUCH BIENNI-
- AL TOWN ELECTION. 15
