AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to awarding an annual annuity to recipients of purple heart medals

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 369 to 2 read as follows:

3 S 369. PAYMENT TO RECIPIENTS OF PURPLE HEART MEDALS. ANNUITY 1. 4 ESTABLISHED. (A) A RECIPIENT OF A PURPLE HEART (AUTHORIZED TO BE 5 AWARDED PURSUANT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER 11016), SHALL UPON APPLICATION TΟ THE STATE DIRECTOR, BE PAID AN ANNUAL ANNUITY OUT OF THE TREASURY OF THE 6 7 FOR THE SUM OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR SUCH TERM AS SUCH RECIPI-STATE 8 ENT SHALL BE ENTITLED THERETO UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.

9 (B) THE ENTITLEMENT OF ANY RECIPIENT OF A PURPLE HEART MEDAL TO 10 RECEIVE THE ANNUITY HEREIN PROVIDED SHALL TERMINATE UPON HIS OR HER DEATH OR UPON HIS OR HER CEASING TO CONTINUE TO BE A RESIDENT AND 11 DOMI-THE STATE OF NEW YORK, BUT SUCH ENTITLEMENT MAY BE REINSTATED 12 CILED IN 13 UPON APPLICATION TO THE STATE DIRECTOR, IF SUCH RECIPIENT SHALL THERE-AFTER RESUME HIS OR HER RESIDENCE AND DOMICILE OF THE STATE. 14

15 THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF AN AWARD OF THE ANNUITY TO A RECIPIENT OF A (C) 16 PURPLE HEART MEDAL SHALL BE THE DAY AFTER THE AWARDING OF A PURPLE HEART MEDAL IF THE APPLICATION THEREFOR IS RECEIVED WITHIN ONE YEAR FROM THE 17 18 DATE OF AWARDING THE PURPLE HEART MEDAL. IF THE APPLICATION IS RECEIVED THE EXPIRATION OF THE FIRST YEAR FOLLOWING THE DATE OF THE AWARD-19 AFTER ING OF THE PURPLE HEART MEDAL, THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF AN 20 AWARD OF THE ANNUITY TO A RECIPIENT OF A PURPLE HEART MEDAL SHALL BE THE DATE OF 21 22 RECEIPT OF THE APPLICATION BY THE STATE DIRECTOR. IF THE APPLICATION IS 23 DENIED BUT IS GRANTED AT A LATER DATE UPON AN APPLICATION FOR RECONSID-24 ERATION BASED UPON NEW EVIDENCE, THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AWARD OF THE

1 ANNUITY TO A RECIPIENT OF A PURPLE HEART MEDAL SHALL BE THE DATE OF THE 2 RECEIPT OF THE APPLICATION FOR RECONSIDERATION BY THE STATE DIRECTOR.

3 (D) ANY APPLICANT CONVICTED OF MAKING ANY FALSE STATEMENT IN THE 4 APPLICATION FOR THE ANNUITY SHALL BE SUBJECT TO PENALTIES PRESCRIBED IN 5 THE PENAL LAW.

6 2. QUALIFICATIONS. (A) ANY RECIPIENT OF A PURPLE HEART MEDAL (AUTHOR-7 IZED TO BE AWARDED PURSUANT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER 11016), WHO IS A RESIDENT 8 OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, SHALL MAKE APPLICATION TO THE DIVISION.

9 (B) NO ENTITLEMENT SHALL BE PAID UNDER THIS SECTION TO OR FOR A RECIP-10 IENT OF A PURPLE HEART MEDAL WHO IS IN PRISON IN A FEDERAL, STATE, OR 11 LOCAL PENAL INSTITUTION AS A RESULT OF CONVICTION OF A FELONY OR MISDE-12 MEANOR FOR ANY PART OF THE PERIOD BEGINNING SIXTY-ONE DAYS AFTER HIS OR 13 HER IMPRISONMENT BEGINS AND ENDING WITH HIS OR HER RELEASE.

14 (C) THE DECISION OF THE DIRECTOR ON MATTERS REGARDING THE PAYMENT OF 15 SUCH ANNUITY SHALL BE FINAL.

16 3. METHOD OF PAYMENT. (A) EVIDENCE OF THE MILITARY SERVICE OF THE 17 RECIPIENT FOR EACH CASE SHALL BE FURNISHED IN THE MANNER AND FORM 18 PRESCRIBED BY THE STATE DIRECTOR.

(B) UPON BEING SATISFIED THAT SUCH SERVICE WAS HONORABLE, THAT OTHER
FACTS AND STATEMENTS IN THE APPLICATION OF SUCH RECIPIENT OF A PURPLE
HEART MEDAL ARE TRUE, THE STATE DIRECTOR SHALL CERTIFY TO THE STATE
COMPTROLLER THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF SUCH RECIPIENT.

(C) THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION AND FINANCE, THROUGH THE
DIVISION OF FINANCE, ON THE AUDIT AND WARRANT OF THE COMPTROLLER, SHALL
PAY SUCH RECIPIENT OF A PURPLE HEART MEDAL SUCH SUM AS IS AUTHORIZED BY
THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION IN SEMI-ANNUAL INSTALLMENTS FOR SO LONG
AS SUCH QUALIFIED RECIPIENT OF A PURPLE HEART MEDAL SHALL MEET THE
REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

4. REPORT. THE STATE DIRECTOR SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR,
THE CHAIR OF THE SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE, AND THE CHAIR OF THE ASSEMBLY
WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE NOT LATER THAN JANUARY FIFTEENTH OF EACH YEAR
THIS SECTION IS IN EFFECT. SUCH REPORT SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO REGULATIONS PROMULGATED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION, AND A
DESCRIPTION AND EVALUATION OF THE PROGRAM.

35 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 36 it shall have become a law; provided rules and regulations necessary for 37 the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized and 38 directed to be made by the division of veterans' affairs on or before 39 such effective date.
