- AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting the sale or distribution of products containing a synthetic cannabinoid

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 1 2 391-s to read as follows:

3 S 391-S. SALE OR DISTRIBUTION OF PRODUCTS CONTAINING A SYNTHETIC CANNABINOID. 1. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, 4 "SYNTHETIC CANNABI-5 NOID" SHALL MEAN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING CHEMICAL COMPOUNDS:

6 HOMOLOGUES: 2-[(1R,3S)-3-HYDROXYCYCLOHEXYL] (A) CP 47.497 AND 7 -5-(2-METHYLOCTAN-2-YL)PHENOL);

8 (B) HU-210: [(6AR, 10AR)-9-(HYDROXYMETHYL)-6,6-DIMETHYL-3- (2-METHY-9 LOCTAN-2-YL)-6A,7,10, 10A-TETRAHYDROBENZO[C] CHROMEN-1-OL)];

10 (C) HU-211: (DEXANABINOL, (6AS, 10AS)-9-(HYDROXYMETHYL) -6, 6-DIMETHYL-3-(2-METHYLOCTAN-2-YL)-6A, 7, 10,11 10A-TETRAHYDROBENZO[C] 12 CHROMEN-1-OL); 13

(D) JWH-018: 1-PENTYL-3-(1-NAPHTHOYL)INDOLE; OR

(E) JWH-073: 1-BUTYL-3-(1-NAPHTHOYL)INDOLE.

NO PERSON, FIRM, CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY OR OTHER ENTITY SHALL SELL, OFFER TO SELL OR GIVE 16 AWAY, AS EITHER A RETAIL OR WHOLESALE PROMOTION, ANY PRODUCT, WHICH 17 CONTAINS A SYNTHETIC CANNABINOID, WHICH MAY ALSO BE REFERRED TO AS K2, 18 19 SPIKE 99, YUCATAN FIRE, SPICE, GENIE OR ZOHAI, EXCEPT AS AUTHORIZED BY 20 SUBDIVISION THREE OF THIS SECTION.

NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY TO NONPRESCRIPTION 1 OVER-THE-COUNTER DRUGS APPROVED OR REGULATED BY THE FEDERAL FOOD AND 2 3 DRUG ADMINISTRATION. 4 4. ANY PERSON, FIRM, CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY OR OTHER ENTITY THAT VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF 5 THIS SECTION BY SELLING, OFFERING TO SELL OR GIVING AWAY AS EITHER A RETAIL 6 7 OR WHOLESALE PROMOTION ANY PRODUCT WHICH CONTAINS A SYNTHETIC CANNABI-NOID, SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY OF NOT MORE THAN FIVE HUNDRED 8 DOLLARS PER VIOLATION, RECOVERABLE IN AN ACTION BY ANY ENFORCEMENT 9 10 AUTHORITY DESIGNATED BY A MUNICIPALITY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE. 11 5.
