AN ACT to amend the domestic relations law, in relation to who may adopt a person

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The closing paragraph of section 110 of the domestic
2 relations law, as added by chapter 522 of the laws of 1999, is amended
3 to read as follows:
4 It shall be unlawful to preclude a prospective adoptive parent or
5 parents solely on the basis that the adoptor or [adopters] ADOPTORS has
6 had, or has cancer, or any other disease. THE PERMANENT IMPAIRMENT OR
7 INCAPACITATION OF ONE SPOUSE SHALL NOT PRECLUDE A HUSBAND AND WIFE FROM
8 ADOPTING TOGETHER OR THE COMPETENT SPOUSE FROM ADOPTING AS A SINGLE
9 PARENT. Nothing herein shall prevent the rejection of a prospective
10 applicant based upon his or her poor health or limited life expectancy.
11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
