AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to eliminating taxes on alternative energies

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 1115 of the tax law is amended
2 by adding a new paragraph 44 to read as follows:
3 (44) ALTERNATIVE ENERGIES FOR USE OR CONSUMPTION AS SET FORTH IN THIS
4 SUBDIVISION. ALTERNATIVE ENERGIES SHALL INCLUDE THOSE WHICH DO NOT RELY
5 ON PETROLEUM PRODUCTS OR NATURAL GAS AS THEIR ENERGY SOURCE.
6 S 2. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 289-g to read as
7 follows:
8 S 289-G. ALTERNATIVE ENERGIES. ANY TAX LEVIED OR IMPOSED BY THIS ARTICLE
9 SHALL NOT APPLY TO ALTERNATIVE ENERGIES. ALTERNATIVE ENERGIES SHALL
10 INCLUDE THOSE WHICH DO NOT RELY ON PETROLEUM PRODUCTS OR NATURAL GAS AS
11 THEIR ENERGY SOURCE.
12 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
