AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to exempting certain old-growth forests from taxation

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of 2 section 480-a of the real property tax law, as amended by chapter 396 of 3 the laws of 2008, is amended and a new subparagraph (iii) is added to 4 read as follows:

5 (ii) participation in a forest certification program (such as Forest 6 Stewardship Council certification, Sustainable Forestry Initiative; 7 American Tree Farm Program, etc.) recognized in the regulations of the 8 department[.]; OR

9 (III) AS TO AN "OLD-GROWTH" ELIGIBLE TRACT, A PLAN THAT INCLUDES PROVISIONS THAT THE OLD-GROWTH FOREST BE PROTECTED WITH MINIMUM MANAGE-10 MENT OR DISTURBANCE THAT ONLY CONSIDERS PASSIVE RECREATIONAL OPPORTU-11 12 NITIES WITH NO CONSTRUCTION OR COMMERCIAL REMOVAL OF TREES. IN THOSE 13 PROTECTION OF THE OLD-GROWTH PROVISIONS, THE FOREST FROM INVASIVE 14 SPECIES AND DISEASES MAY BE CONSIDERED.

15 S 2. Paragraph (h) of subdivision 1 of section 480-a of the real prop-16 erty tax law is relettered paragraph (i) and a new paragraph (h) is 17 added to read as follows:

18 (H) "OLD-GROWTH ELIGIBLE TRACT" SHALL MEAN A TRACT THAT CONFORMS WITH 19 THE DEFINITION OF "OLD-GROWTH FOREST" CONTAINED IN SUBDIVISION SIX OF 20 SECTION 45-0105 OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW.

S 3. Paragraph (d) of subdivision 5 of section 480-a of the real property tax law is relettered paragraph (e) and a new paragraph (d) is added to read as follows:

1 (D) NO CUTTING OF FOREST CROP SHALL BE PERMITTED IN ANY APPROVED OLD 2 GROWTH ELIGIBLE TRACT EXCEPT TO PROTECT THE OLD GROWTH FOREST FROM INVA-3 SIVE SPECIES OR DISEASE.

4 S 5. Subdivision 6 of section 480-a of the real property tax law is 5 amended by adding a new paragraph (e) to read as follows:

6 (E) NO CUTTING OF FOREST CROP SHALL BE MANDATED OR PERMITTED IN ANY 7 APPROVED OLD GROWTH ELIGIBLE TRACT EXCEPT TO PROTECT THE OLD GROWTH 8 FOREST FROM INVASIVE SPECIES OR DISEASE.

9 S 5. This act shall take effect January 1, 2012 and shall apply to 10 taxable years beginning on and after such date.
