AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring every keeper of a hotel or motel or inn to make condoms available for sale to guests

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 204-b to read as follows:

S 204-B. SALE OF CONDOMS. EVERY KEEPER OF A HOTEL OR MOTEL OR INN SHALL, IN THE REGISTRATION OFFICE, SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE TO REGISTERED GUESTS OF SUCH HOTEL OR MOTEL OR INN CONDOMS OR SIMILAR PROPHYLACTIC DEVICES DESIGNED TO PREVENT CONCEPTION OR VENEREAL INFECTION DURING SEXUAL INTERCOURSE.
