AN ACT to amend the general obligations law, in relation to contracts relating or referring to hydraulic fracturing

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The general obligations law is amended by adding a new 2 section 5-336 to read as follows:
 - S 5-336. HYDRAULIC FRACTURING CONTRACTS. 1. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "HYDRAULIC FRACTURING," "HYDRO-FRACTURING" AND "HYDRO-FRACKING" SHALL MEAN FRACTURING OF ROCK BY MAN-MADE FLUID-DRIVEN FRACTURING TECHNIQUES FOR THE PURPOSE OF STIMULATING NATURAL GAS OR OIL WELL PRODUCTION.
- 8 2. NO CONTRACT RELATING OR REFERRING TO HYDRAULIC FRACTURING, 9 HYDRO-FRACTURING OR HYDRO-FRACKING SHALL:
- 10 A. PROHIBIT THE DISCLOSURE, BY ANY PARTY, OF THE CHEMICALS USED IN 11 HYDRAULIC FRACTURING; OR
- 12 B. DIMINISH PAYMENT TO ANY CONTRACTING PARTY AS A RESULT OF THE INCLU-
- 13 SION OF A PROVISION DISCLOSING THE CHEMICALS USED IN HYDRAULIC FRACTUR-14 ING.
- 15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
