AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to crane operations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 483 of the general business law, as amended by section 19 of part CC of chapter 57 of the laws of 2009, is amended to read as follows:

4 2. A. Such regulations may provide for examinations, categories of 5 certificates, licenses, or registrations, age and experience require-6 ments, payment of fees, and may also provide for such limitations and 7 exemptions as the commissioner finds necessary and proper.

8 IN THE CASE OF CRANE OPERATORS, SUCH REGULATIONS SHALL REQUIRE THE Β. 9 COMMISSIONER TO ISSUE A NEW YORK STATE CRANE OPERATOR'S CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCE, AUTHORIZING SUCH INDIVIDUAL TO OPERATE A CRANE IN NEW YORK 10 STATE, TO ANY INDIVIDUAL UPON SUBMISSION OF PROOF THAT 11 SUCH INDIVIDUAL EITHER BEEN ISSUED: (I) A CRANE OPERATOR'S LICENSE BY THE NATIONAL 12 HAS COMMISSION FOR CERTIFICATION OF CRANE OPERATORS; 13 OR (II) A NATIONAL 14 CRANE LICENSE ΒY THE FEDERAL OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH ADMINIS-15 TRATION.

16 C. In the case of blasters and pyrotechnicians, such regulations may 17 require fingerprinting, and in the case of users of radioactive materi-18 al, such regulations may require the posting of a bond or other securi-19 ty.

20 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
