AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the state emergency medical advisory committee

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 3002-a of the public health law,
2 as added by chapter 804 of the laws of 1992, is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 1. There shall be a state emergency medical advisory committee of the
5 state emergency medical services council consisting of [twenty-nine]
6 THIRTY-ONE members. [Twenty-one] TWENTY-THREE members shall be physi-
7 cians appointed by the commissioner, including one from each regional
8 emergency medical [advisory committee] SERVICES COUNCIL and an addi-
9 tional physician from the city of New York [and at least], one pediatri-
10 cian, one trauma surgeon, [and] one psychiatrist AND THE CHAIRPERSON AS
11 APPOINTED BY THE COMMISSIONER. Each of the physicians shall have demon-
12 strated knowledge and experience in emergency medical services. There
13 shall be eight non-physician non-voting members appointed by the chair-
14 person of the state council, at least five of whom shall be members of
15 the state emergency medical services council at the time of their
16 appointment. At least one of the eight shall be an emergency nurse, at
17 least one shall be an advanced emergency medical technician, at least
18 one shall be a basic emergency medical technician, and at least one
19 shall be employed in a hospital setting with administrative responsibil-
20 ity for a hospital emergency department or service. [The commissioner
21 shall appoint a physician to chair the committee.]

22 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after
23 it shall have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediate-
24 ly, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation
25 necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are
26 authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such
27 effective date.
