4 S 2812. RESTRICTIONS OF THE TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS. NOTWITHSTANDING
5 ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, NO FUNCTION WHICH IS PRIMA-
6 RILY PERFORMED BY A DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY OF THE STATE SHALL BE TRANS-
7 FERRED TO, OR ASSUMED BY, OR PERFORMED BY, A REGULATED PUBLIC AUTHORITY
8 AS DEFINED BY THIS TITLE, UNLESS SUCH TRANSFER OF FUNCTION OR ASSUMPTION
9 OR PERFORMANCE IS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED IN LAW BY AN ACT OF THE STATE
10 LEGISLATURE.
11 S 2813. CIVIL SERVICE STATUS OF EMPLOYEES. ANY EMPLOYEE OF A REGU-
12 LATED PUBLIC AUTHORITY AS DEFINED BY THIS TITLE, WHO IS HIRED AFTER THE
13 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS TITLE, SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE IN THE CLASSIFIED
14 CIVIL SERVICE AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL
15 SERVICE LAW IN THE SAME MANNER AS AN EMPLOYEE OF A DEPARTMENT OF THE
16 STATE.
17 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall
18 have become a law.
