AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to the sale of wine supplies and accessories

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 63 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 603 of the laws of 1992, is amended and a new subdivision 7 is added to read as follows:
- 4. No licensee under this section shall be engaged in any other business on the licensed premises. The sale of lottery tickets, when duly 5 authorized and lawfully conducted, the sale of corkscrews or the sale of 7 ice or the sale of publications, including prerecorded video and/or audio cassette tapes, designed to help educate consumers in their know-9 ledge and appreciation of wine and wine products, as defined in section 10 three of this chapter, or the sale of non-carbonated, non-flavored mineral waters, spring waters and drinking waters or the [sale of glass-11 designed for the consumption of wine, racks designed for the storage 12 13 of wine, and devices designed to minimize oxidation in bottles of wine 14 which have been uncorked] SALE OF WINE SUPPLIES AND ACCESSORIES, WHICH 15 SHALL INCLUDE ANY ITEM UTILIZED FOR THE STORAGE, TRANSPORT, SERVING OR 16 CONSUMPTION OF WINE OR FOR DECORATIVE PURPOSES WHETHER SOLD AS SINGLE 17 ITEMS OR COMBINED INTO A PACKAGE CONTAINING WINE OR A WINE shall not constitute engaging in another business within the meaning of 18 19 this subdivision.
  - 7. NO LICENSEE MAY BE ASSESSED A CIVIL PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION OF SUBDIVISION FOUR OF THIS SECTION, UNLESS THEY HAVE FIRST BEEN GIVEN A WRITTEN WARNING FROM THE LIQUOR AUTHORITY, AFFORDING THEM NO LESS THAN THIRTY DAYS NOTICE WITHIN WHICH TO CEASE ENGAGING IN OTHER BUSINESSES ON THE LICENSED PREMISES. SUCH WARNING SHALL ENUMERATE THE SPECIFIC ITEMS WHICH MUST BE REMOVED TO COMPLY WITH SUBDIVISION FOUR OF THIS SECTION.
    - S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
