AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to modifying the exemption from welfare work requirements for a parent or other relative of a child up to age two

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subdivision 1 of section 332 of the social services law, as amended by section 148 of part B of chapter 436 of the laws of 1997, is amended to read as follows:

(d) a parent or other relative of a child who is personally providing care for such child under [one year] TWO YEARS of age for a [maximum] period of [twelve] TWENTY-FOUR months[, only three months of which shall be attributable to any one child, except as otherwise extended up to the twelve month period by the social services official];

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
