AN ACT to authorize the town of Thompson, in the county of Sullivan, to establish a special improvement district to be known as the "Treasure Lake/Davies dam improvement district"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the town of Thompson, in the county of Sullivan, shall be authorized and enabled to establish a special improvement district to be know as the "Treasure Lake/Davies dam improvement district". Such district shall be established in accordance with the provisions of articles 12 and 12-A of the town law for the establishment, funding and operation of special improvement districts. In particular, and to the extent practicable, the Treasure Lake/Davies dam improvement district shall be subject to the provision of such articles which are applicable to water districts.
- (b) The purpose of the Treasure Lake/Davies dam improvement district shall be to provide for the repair, reconstruction and maintenance of the Treasure Lake/Davies dam and spillway to prevent dam failure or breach.
- (c) The costs and expenses of the operation of the Treasure Lake/Davies dam improvement district shall be paid through the levy of special assessments upon all lots or parcels of land within such district either in proportion to the benefit derived therefrom.
- 19 (d) The town of Thompson and the Treasure Lake/Davies dam improvement 20 district are hereby authorized to issue bonds and notes pursuant to the 21 provisions of the local finance law applicable to special improvement 22 districts.
- 23 S 2. Severability. If any provision of this act or the application 24 thereof to any person or circumstance is adjudged invalid by a court of

competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or impair any other provisions or applications of this act which can be effected without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are severable.
