AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to collection of supervision fees from persons on community supervision

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 9 of section 201 of the correction law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph (e) to read as follows:
  - (E) (I) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, RULE OR REGULATION TO THE CONTRARY, AND EXCEPT AS PROVIDED FOR IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE SUPERVISION FEE AUTHORIZED BY THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT BE COLLECTED BY THE PAROLE OFFICER OF A PERSON ON COMMUNITY SUPERVISION. THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH ALTERNATIVE METHODS FOR PAYMENT OF SUCH SUPERVISION FEE BY PERSONS ON COMMUNITY SUPERVISION.

- 10 (II) AT ANY REPORTING LOCATION NOT UNDER THE DOMINION AND CONTROL OF 11 THE DEPARTMENT, THE PAROLE OFFICER MAY BE AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT THE 12 SUPERVISION FEE.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that the amendments to subdivision 9 of section 201 of the correction law made by section one of this act shall not affect the repeal of such subdivision and shall be deemed repealed therewith.
