AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to requiring the promulgation of regulations relating to the commercial trade of human reproductive processes and limiting the number of live births from a single semen donor

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivisions 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of section 4365 of the public 2 health law are renumbered subdivisions 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 and a new subdi-3 vision 3 is added to read as follows:

4 3. THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE TRANSPLANT COUNCIL, 5 SHALL PROMULGATE REGULATIONS ON THE COMMERCIAL TRADE OF HUMAN REPRODUC-6 TIVE PROCESSES INVOLVING SEMEN DONATION. SUCH REGULATIONS SHALL INCLUDE, 7 BUT SHALL NOT BE LIMITED TO:

8 (A) GOVERNING LIMITS ON THE NUMBER OF LIVE BIRTHS CONCEIVED BY A9 SINGLE DONOR, WHICH SHALL NOT EXCEED TEN LIVE BIRTHS; AND

(B) THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CENTRAL TRACKING REGISTRY 10 OF SEMEN DONOR 11 ΒY REPRODUCTIVE TISSUE INFORMATION, AS REPORTED BANKS, 12 INSEMINATION/IMPLANTATION SITES AND SEMEN PROCESSING FACILITIES IN THE 13 SUCH REGISTRY SHALL PROVIDE A MEANS FOR GATHERING AND MAINTAIN-STATE. 14 ING ACCURATE INFORMATION ON THE:

(I) NUMBER OF LIVE BIRTHS CONCEIVED FROM A SINGLE DONOR;

16 (II) HEALTH INFORMATION OF THE DONOR AT THE TIME OF THE DONATION; AND 17 (III) OTHER INFORMATION DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE COMMISSIONER.

18 IN ADDITION, REGULATIONS SHALL MAINTAIN THE ANONYMITY OF THE DONOR AND 19 THE OFFSPRING AND GOVERN ACCESS TO INFORMATION MAINTAINED BY THE REGIS-20 TRY.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided that the commissioner of health shall promulgate regulations no later than six months after this act shall have become a law.
