AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system to be known as the "Peconic highway"

PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 342-aaa 2 to read as follows:
 - 342-AAA. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS THE "PECONIC HIGHWAY". ALL THAT PORTION OF THESTATE SYSTEM KNOWN AS STATE ROUTE 24 WHICH IS LOCATED IN THE TOWNS OF SOUTH-AMPTON AND BROOKHAVEN, COUNTY OF SUFFOLK AND WHICH BEGINS AT ITS WESTER-LY JUNCTION WITH INTERSTATE 495 AND ENDS AT ITS EASTERLY JUNCTION WITH STATE ROUTE 27, SHALL BE DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS THE PECONIC HIGHWAY.
- The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-10 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 13 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be 14 15 changed as a result of this act.
- S 3. This act shall take effect immediately. 16
